Objectives: The objective of this event is to exhibit the latest ICT technology supporting healthcare in all its aspects. This implies that a rich variety of ICT system vendors will be present.

The goal of IHE at this event is to inform the participants of solutions to interoperability and integration, by means of presentations and live demonstrations. The demonstrations center around successful implementations in The Netherlands. This has to lead to more awareness of and interest in IHE.

IT Infrastructure – XDS-I

At the booth this is done through two examples: **MammoXL** (a pilot of breast cancer screening in The Netherlands) and **eRadiology** (a program to streamline the exchange of exams and reports among radiology departments throughout the Netherlands)

Patient Care Devices – DEC, also shown at the booth

Outside the pavilion the participants can enjoy an XDS-I demonstration called JMC (Jaarbeurs Medical Center). This concerns a walk along the different booths of a selected set of IHE-members. At the start the participant is question is provided with a fictitious PHR and can view, change, enrich this along the way, that is at each of these booths where different XDS-I consumers or actors play a role. After each booth demo, the “patient” gets a stamp and when he/she has sufficient stamps, a token can be collected at the IHE Pavilion.

It should be noted that all these demonstrations are preceded by a mini-connectathon, one month before the actual event. A prerequisite to attend this mini-connectathon is that the vendor in question has participated in the real connectathons in the past, or at least has tested his software against the MESA or any other IHE-compliant tool.

This form will be used by IHE-Europe to improve the coordination and visibility across of these various national and European IHE demonstrations.

IHE Europe plans to use this information to:

- Promote national IHE demonstrations and ensure their visibility at the European-level. These IHE national demonstrations are organized under the responsibility of IHE national initiatives.
- Organize a few well targeted European-level IHE demonstrations under the responsibility of IHE Europe.

Participation to the IHE European Connectathon is an IHE requirement for participating in a sponsored IHE demonstration. Each participating system must successfully complete all required tests as a requirement for participation.
