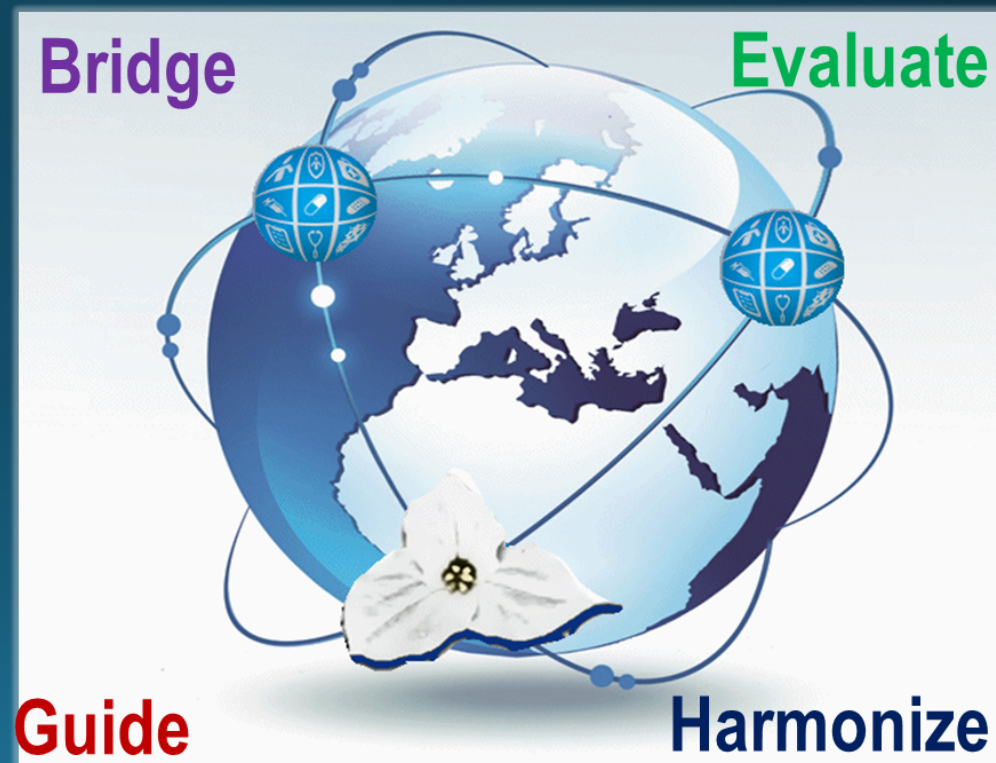


Mission EU/US Memorandum of Understanding

 - entry point with key information related to the current situation for navigation to more detailed data

Scaling-up the use of patient summaries

- In case of **Emergency**, the patient summary is there in our mobile phone and can be understood anywhere in the world
- **Emergency response teams** can use the patient summaries to capture accurately the aggregate and individual needs of a community hampered by disaster.



Trillium-II's ambition touches the person through their personal hub and the community through an aggregating dashboard making the most of our data-driven economy.

- **Engage and educate the stakeholders about the social value of the international patient summary**
 - What are the use cases beyond emergency and unplanned care?
 - Is the proposed content what we need?
 - What are the flows of information?
 - How is information governed?
 - What are the standards?

 - discuss experience from affiliated pilot projects
 - Contribute our feedback to standards development
