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## IHE Working Group: Care processes

First Working Group that has not an IHE profile as starting point

### New main principles:

- Taking care processes in a certain domain as starting point
- So not from 'system to system' but from 'healthcare professional to healthcare professional' = covers the whole careprocess
- Working from 'building blocks' as much as possible
- Structured approach (ISO TR28380)
- Vendor neutral
- Focus on pragmatic interoperability/information problems
- Outcome not limited to IHE





# 13 Impact-of IHE guidelines

## Developed 2 IHE Guidelines (available in English)














