FHIR: All about working with other people

- Open Community
- Open Standard (Open license)
- Web based Technology
- Make the MoUs real
 - Make profiling fundamental in the tools
 - Make terminology fundamental
 - Common publishing framework
 - Common Testing process (usages differ)
 - Demonstrate success iteratively
 - Recognise different value offerings





FHIR: IPS

- Common international base
- Lowest Common Denominator
- Common terminology
 - too high for lots of people
 - Too low for lots of people
- Starting to get wide adoption





IP-Summary vs IP-Access

IPS

- Document Format
- Agreed Content Model
 - Use parts of the document
- Not much agreement about access / handling

IPA

- API specification
- Agreed Access protocol (security)
- Not much agreement about content



Where are we going

- Slowly building community and impetus
- Continue showing benefit iteratively
- Develop and invest in coordination structures (Gemini)
- Execute on the FHIR Community Process
 - Transparency / Acountability
 - Longevity arrangements
 - Document how requirements are met
