

MyHealth@EU is a functional, robust European health data infrastructure that connects 10 MS and will expand to cover the entire EU + Norway and Iceland. Current cross-border services include Patient Summary and ePrescription, but will be expanded to lab results, hospital discharge reports, medical images and more.

#### WHY ARE WE DOING THIS?


What are the purposes and benefits of achieving interoperability of medical records in the EU?

- Ensuring continuity of healthcare for patients when receiving treatment in another EU country
- Providing more reliable information in own language to healthcare professionals about the treated foreign patient
- Medical data travels WITH/FOR patients within EU
- Security and trust -> exchange of highly sensitive medical patient information in a reliable, secure and robust infrastructure – not over the internet!
- Learning about good practice in eHealth from other MS (standardization, ....)
- Beneficial co-operation between MS/COM/NCPeH/healthcare providers in EU






## Challenges to overcome!

- Different level of data quality in MS.
- Introduction of new international standards to the national level.
- Necessary legal/organizational changes.
- Explaining the benefits to the stakeholders politicians, decisionmakers, healthcare professionals, patients, IT experts.
- Insufficient human capacities on the side of implementing teams.
- Sucessful completion of all prerequisites to "go live" with a crossborder service.....and stay alive.


# Challenges that lie before us in near future...
